Current Ministry - Visitation@Macpherson

Every third Saturday of the month, we gather at Block 65 Circuit Road and divide into three to four teams to visit approximately 18 nearby households. Most of these families are non-believers within the community, and this visitation ministry has been faithfully carried out for the past five to six years.

The purpose of these visits is not merely to conduct one-time evangelistic activities, but to build genuine relationships through long-term, consistent care and companionship. By listening, showing concern, praying for them, and sharing in their everyday lives, we seek to help them experience the love of Christ. At appropriate opportunities, we also share the message of the Gospel with them, hoping that one day they will come to know the Lord Jesus and receive the salvation He offers.

This ministry requires patience, compassion, and perseverance. Many times, a simple greeting, a moment of companionship, or an act of care can become a vessel through which God works in people's lives. As the Bible says:

And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

Current Ministry - Gelang Patah Holy Word Church Children Camp

Since 2023, a group of brothers and sisters from GBC have been participating in the children' s camps organized by Gelang Patah Holy Word Church, Johor, through Brother Samuel' s connections and on an individual basis. Through serving together, they have built a meaningful partnership with the local church.

In 2025, we officially began collaborating with the church to jointly organize the children' s camp, working together across churches to bring the Gospel to more children.

Under God' s guidance, this ministry has continued to experience growth and breakthroughs. In 2025, the camp expanded from a one-day event to a two-day, one-night camp, providing children with more opportunities to build relationships and learn about the Gospel.

In 2026, the camp further developed by incorporating large-scale outdoor activities and specially designed evening fellowship sessions. These programs encouraged interaction and mentorship between the youth of Gelang Patah Holy Word Church and older children aged 9 to 12, creating opportunities for spiritual nurture and the passing on of faith to the next generation.

Over the years, we have witnessed many encouraging outcomes. In 2026, a total of 77 children participated in the camp, reflecting steady growth in attendance. Even more encouragingly, many of the children who attended the camp have continued to participate in the weekly children' s gatherings organized by the local church, growing in their faith journey. Some have also responded to the Gospel during the camp and accepted Jesus Christ as the Savior of their lives.

The children' s camp is not merely an event; it is a long-term platform for sowing seeds of faith, building relationships, and nurturing disciples. We firmly believe that God can use every act of service and dedication to leave an eternal impact on the lives of these children.

We warmly invite brothers and sisters to join this ministry. Whether through participating in planning and preparation, leading activities, accompanying and caring for the children, providing administrative support, or upholding the ministry in prayer, we can all become instruments in God' s hands, bringing Christ' s love and the Gospel to the next generation.

Current Ministry - Health Talks for the Seniors

The church regularly invites a experienced Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) practitioner to conduct health talks, providing easy-to-understand guidance that helps seniors learn how to apply the wisdom of TCM in maintaining a healthy lifestyle. Topics covered include basic knowledge of Chinese herbs, acupressure and acupoint wellness practices, healthy daily habits, as well as preventive and management strategies for common chronic conditions such as high blood pressure, diabetes, and high cholesterol.

This ministry is primarily aimed at seniors within the community and serves as a pre-evangelistic outreach ministry. Through health-related topics that are of common interest, we hope to invite members of the community into the church, where they can build relationships and friendships in a warm and welcoming environment while experiencing the care and acceptance of the church. Through ongoing companionship and genuine concern, we also hope to encourage them to learn more about Christ and participate in worship services and other church gatherings.

By God' s grace, this ministry has maintained a steady level of participation, including several non-believers who continue to attend the talks regularly. We firmly believe that every sincere act of care and every meaningful interaction can become a testimony of God' s love and help pave the way for the Gospel.

We warmly invite brothers and sisters to participate in this ministry. Whether through assisting with hospitality, offering care and support through conversations, inviting family members and friends, preparing refreshments, or supporting the ministry through prayer, each of us can become a vessel through which God blesses the seniors in our community. Current Ministry - Mentoring@Macpherson

To care for students and families within the community, the church has established the Mentoring@MacPherson Ministry, providing Chinese language and Mathematics tuition for students from primary to secondary school levels. Through academic support and companionship, we hope to help students build confidence in their learning while easing the educational pressures and burdens faced by their parents.

This ministry serves as a pre-evangelistic outreach, aiming to invite children and families from the community into the church, where relationships and friendships can be developed through the learning process. Through the teachers' patient instruction, genuine care, and the welcoming embrace of the church community, we hope that participating students and their parents will experience the love of Christ. In due time, we also seek to invite them to worship services and other church gatherings, helping them come to know the Gospel more deeply.

Although the number of participants is currently modest, we firmly believe that this is a ministry entrusted to us by God. We trust that, in His perfect timing, God will provide all that is needed—both families who are willing to participate and workers who are willing to commit themselves to serving. 3. It is also to develop participants’ ability to reproduce and pass on this ministry, so that they not only become capable of sharing the Gospel themselves, but are also able to teach and lead fellow believers to actively participate in evangelism together.

Existing Ministry - Missions Ministry

Existing Ministry - 2025 Northern Thailand Mission Exploration Trip

27/02/2025 - 07/03/2025 Northern Thailand Mission Exploration Trip

Exploration Team: 林耿恩牧师, 杨应辉长老, 刘英吉执事, 梁勇强执事, 陈玉英姐妹

1. Objectives:

- To visit 古应隆牧师 and his wife and provide material assistance to refugees in need.
- To gain a better understanding of 古应隆牧师 and his wife's ministries and current situation in the Mae Sai region of Northern Thailand.
- To partner with 晏发嵩牧师 in Northern Thailand to provide material support to Hmong refugees in the Muan Ka Lang area.
- To learn about the needs and ministry developments in other regions of Northern Thailand through 晏发嵩牧师's sharing.

2. Material Assistance Efforts

- **Mae Sai:** Visited 古应隆牧师 and his wife. Distributed relief supplies to 26 refugee families (15 kg of rice and 4 bottles of cooking oil per household). In addition, 100 kg of clothing from Singapore was distributed to 55 - 60 children from the En Ai Fellowship.
- **Muan Ka Lang:** Partnered with 晏发嵩牧师 to distribute supplies to impoverished Hmong refugees who had fled to Muan Ka Lang, assisting 100 Hmong refugee families (7 kg of rice and 2 bottles of cooking oil per household).

3. Ministry Research and Pioneer Work Assessment

- **Land Planning:** Conducted a site visit to inspect land recommended by 古应隆牧师 for future church and school development, evaluating the feasibility and potential for constructing a chapel and school.
- **Chiang Rai En Fu Church:** Met with 何永在牧师 and his wife to discuss the student center ministry and the current situation and challenges of local evangelistic pioneer work.
- **"Hui Dou" Hmong Evangelistic Outreach Center, Northern Thailand:** Hui Dou is a village with no believers. The ministry team currently consists of three missionaries and one teacher from Malaysia.

Through Chinese tuition classes, they engage with local children and gradually build relationships with families through home visitation.

- **"Morning Sun Home" in Mae Salong:** Met with 晏发嵩牧师 to learn about the orphanage ministry and the encouraging reality that some children who grew up there have returned to serve in the ministry.

Existing Ministry - 2025 Yangon Mission Exploration Trip

1. Ministry Development

- **Urban Church Planting:** Together with 李有福牧师, Chairman of Myanmar Gospel Fellowship, we visited Mingalardon to explore opportunities for a church planting initiative. Also present were 彭冬兰牧师, 王德常牧师, and 和龚兴能牧师. The project is currently overseen by 龚兴能牧师. This new mission field, focused on urban church planting, is a collaborative initiative that requires continued prayer and further discussion.
- **Slum Ministry:** We thank God for the opportunity to meet 高菊兰姐妹, who oversees the "House of Righteousness" Sunday School ministry serving 150 children in the slums of Yangon, Myanmar. We provided support by assisting her in purchasing a new venue for children's ministry activities and other necessities. We also gained a deeper understanding of the practical needs of the youth mentors and children's Sunday School ministry, while discussing potential training partnerships for the coming year.

2. Testimony of Mission History

- **30th Anniversary of Pathein Church:** We also have a special reason to thank and praise God! 杨应辉长老 had the privilege of representing Grace Baptist Church at the **30th Pearl Jubilee Thanksgiving Celebration of Pathein Grace Baptist Church** on 11 October.

Pathein Grace Baptist Church was established through a missionary partnership between Grace Baptist Church and the Myanmar Christian Preachers Training Institute (MCPTI) / Myanmar Gospel Fellowship. Located in the Ayeyarwady Region of Myanmar, it was the first Chinese church established in the area (1995 - 2025).

Prayer Requests for Lashio, Myanmar: 古应隆牧师 and 杨仙惠传道

- Pray that the spiritual lives of the brothers and sisters at Lashio Life Church will be rekindled, that they will continually hunger for God's truth and draw near to the Heavenly Father wholeheartedly.
- Pray for wisdom and strength as Sheng Hui School, a ministry under Life Church, officially begins classes on March 1.
- Pray for 古应隆牧师's eldest daughter, 古荣甜, as she studies in Taiwan, asking God to grant her physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being.
- On March 23, 杨仙惠传道, together with the children and 19 family members, returned from Mae Sai, Thailand, to Lashio, Myanmar. We thank God for granting them a safe journey over the two-day trip.
- Pray for Life Church as they undertake extensive cleaning, rebuild boundary walls, resettle the ministry, and reconnect with members who have drifted away.

Prayer Requests for Northern Thailand: 晏发嵩牧师 / Morning Sun Home

- Pray for the future planning of the Chinese Christian Mission Thailand ministry. 晏发嵩牧师 is expected to establish a CCM office in Bangkok in June. The primary objective is to mobilize local Thai churches (urban churches) to participate in rural evangelistic ministries.
- Pray for 晏发嵩牧师 and 刘牧师 as they conduct their first exploratory visit to Bangkok. Ask God to lead them and provide a suitable location.
- Pray for the physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being of the teachers and students at Morning Sun Home (Student Center), and for the students' continued progress in their studies.
- Pray for the living expenses of the 62 underprivileged children at Morning Sun Home. May God move churches to continue supporting this ministry.

(S\$100 per child per month × 12 months = S\$1,200 annually per child)

- From **July 2025 to July 2026**, Grace Baptist Church has sponsored **10 underprivileged children**.

- From **August 2026 to August 2027**, we intend to sponsor **10 underprivileged children** and urgently need to raise **S\$12,000**.
